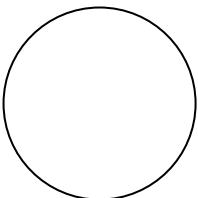


MAA vs. Wild

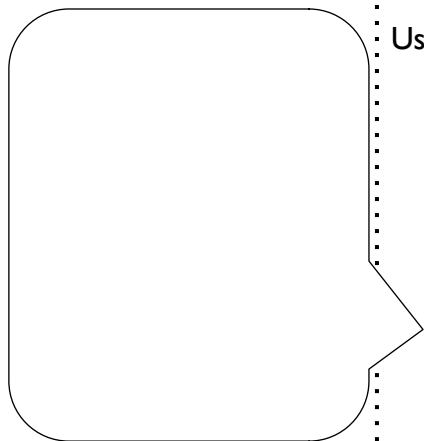
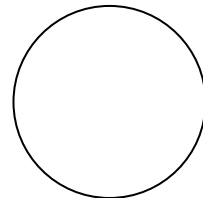
I counted brooches.

Young people in Anglo-Saxon times were sometimes buried with beautiful treasures such as brooches. Can you find a case full of brooches?

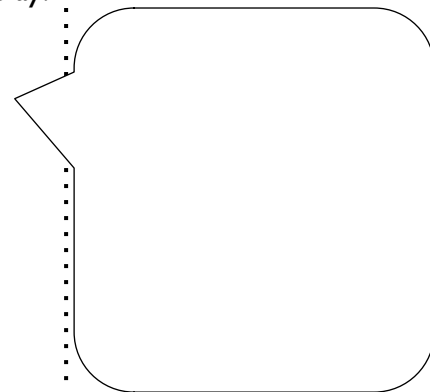

A child probably carved the figures of a knight and a beast into the column of a church in Norfolk. We think the two figures are characters from a play.

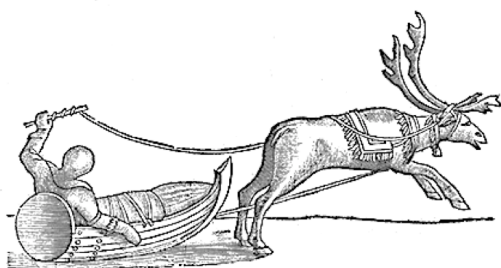

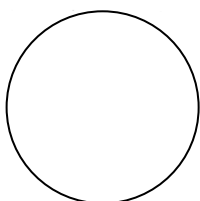
First Floor: World Anthropology Gallery
